# NEW RECYCLING GUIDELINES

---

*The items are to be sorted as follows:*

## **BIN ONE [RIGIDS]**

*All aluminum cans; tin cans; and plastics numbers 1 through 7 shall be placed in one bin. Residents may discard all aluminums, tins and plastics in the bin together. Separation within the bin is no longer required.*

## **BIN TWO [FIBERS]**

*All newspapers, magazines, junk mail and phonebooks shall be placed in one bin. Residents may discard all newspapers, magazines, junk mail and phonebooks in the bin together. Separation within the bin is no longer required.*

## **CARDBOARD**

*Cardboard, including paperboard [i.e. cereal boxes, etc.], must be flattened and bound, no larger than 24" x 24" x 12". The cardboard may be placed on top of or alongside the bins.*

## **SHREDDED PAPER**

*Shredded paper must be placed in a paper bag and marked "Shredded Paper" on the outside of the bag. If the shredded paper is in a plastic bag, it will be refused.*

## **FOOD AND BEVERAGE GLASS**

*Food and beverage glass will need to be in a separate non-closed or non-tied container such as a pail, paper bag or small box. The container may be placed on top of the paper-type bin.*

## **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR RECYCLING**

Pie tins, aluminum foil, aerosol cans, hangers, broken glass, light bulbs, mirror glass, window glass, drinking glasses, vases, plastic bags, Tupperware, Rubbermaid, Styrofoam products, hard covered books, carbon or coated paper, wax covered boxes, milk cartons, foam egg cartons, and plastics without a recycling number or a recycling number higher than 7.

Items placed in a plastic bag or any other bag that has been tied will be rejected.

## **GARBAGE**

Garbage bags must be tied closed and not weigh more than of 30 pounds. Garbage bags may be purchased from City Hall, Coborn's Superstore, Ace Hardware, Hardware Hank, and SuperAmerica. Belle Prairie Junction carries green bags only.
