The stormwater fee of \$1.03 is to pay for existing and future storm water improvements.

The drinking water fee is \$.53. The State of Minnesota mandates that all cities collect this fee and send to them for to fund the State Drinking Water Protection Program. For more information go to: http://www.health.state.mn.us/water/

The final item on your utility bill is sales tax.

EXPLANATION OF FEES

*The Water and Sewer Surcharges are used to pay the debt obligations for the Water and Wastewater Treatment facilities; in addition to paying for continued maintenance and improvements to both facilities.

**Sewer Only accounts properties that have a private well connected to the City's sewer system. The sewer charges for these accounts are billed based on 5,000 gallon consumption. Property owners have the option of metering their well water so sewer charges are based on actual consumption.

- *Drive-by fees are paid to the haulers for picking up the items.
- **Garbage and recycling administrative costs are used to pay for the garbage canisters, postage, reporting, staff time, etc.
