

SWIMMING POOLS

PERMITS

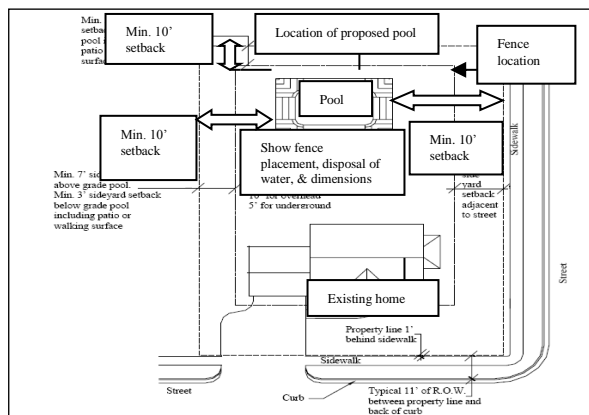
A building permit is required for a pool that is to be constructed, erected, or maintained and is of a depth over 18 inches and having a plane surface of greater than 50 square feet, (over 8 feet in diameter for around pool). Materials used shall have adequate strength to retain water and is designed to contain the amount at the water at maximum capacity. Every pool that fits the description above shall be completely enclosed with a 4 foot high fence. All openings, holes and gaps shall be no larger than 4" inches.

SUBMITTALS REQUIRED FOR PERMIT

(2) copies of site plans showing proposed designs and materials.

Drawings are to be drawn to scale on paper and may include:

- **Site Plan** providing:
 - Existing structures, lot dimensions, and the location of the proposed swimming pool.
 - Plan for the disposal of water for when water overflows from pool and when the pool is emptied.
 - Location of fence. (Min. fence height of 4 feet and gaps in fence less than 4 inches)
- **Cross Sections and/or Elevations** providing:
 - Size of swimming pool including depth, surface area, and diameter of the pool.
 - Type/Materials of swimming pool.
 - Show self-closing and self-catching device(s) for all gates and doors on the fence.



REQUIRED INSPECTIONS

When a building permit is required for a pool, the following inspection must be requested:

- **Footing Inspection** – when pool is below grade and permanent in design
- **Final Site Inspection** – approve pool location (10 feet from any lot line)
- **Final Fence Inspection** – after fence has been erected
