SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ APRIL 4, 2016

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hanfler on April 4, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Councilmembers Boyum, Hircock, Liljegren, Hanson, Council President Hanfler, and Mayor Zylka were present. Councilmembers Gosiak and Knafla were absent. It was determined there was a quorum.

2. **PUBLIC FORUM**

a. Robin Hensel, 807 Southeast First Street, reviewed: 1] concerns regarding Camp Ripley and their ties with local grocery store and individuals she believes were employed there; 2] their lack of permits; and 3] second highest suicide rate of the United States is Minnesota.

3. **COUNCIL INFORMATIONAL ONLY ITEMS**

a. **Energy and Environmental Committee Recommendation, Garbage and Recycling Contracts** – City Administrator Radermacher and Finance Officer Kasella reviewed the recommendations of the Energy and Environmental Committee regarding the garbage and recycling contracts which are up at the end of the year. b. **Independent School District 482 Referendum** – The City Council reviewed and discussed the upcoming referendum on May 10, 2016, by Independent School District 482. No action taken.

c. **Joint City/County Meeting** – City Administrator Radermacher reviewed a proposed date and time for the City Council and County Commissioners to meet. Following discussions, it was the consensus of the City Council that another date be determined as not all of the City Council was available.

d. **Website Request for Proposals Review Committee** – City Administrator Radermacher requested that a couple members of the City Council work with staff and report back with a recommendation on the website Request for Proposals. It was the consensus of the City Council that Mayor Zylka and Councilmember Gosiak work with staff.
