

SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ AUGUST 1, 2016

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hanfler on August 1, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Councilmembers Boyum, Hircock, Liljegren, Hanson, Gosiak, Knafla, Council President Hanfler, and Mayor Zylka were present. It was determined there was a quorum.

2. **PUBLIC FORUM**

a. Daniel Boerner, 500 Southeast Third Avenue, reviewed: his request that the City Council allow the raising of chickens within the City.

b. Robin Hensel, 807 Southeast First Street, reviewed: 1] trees within Pine Grove Park; and 2] she will be filing an official complaint regarding the lack of a cable TV franchise in place.

3. **COUNCIL INFORMATIONAL ONLY ITEMS**

a. **Urban Chickens** – Following discussions regarding a request to allow residents to raise urban chickens within the City, the City Council requested that residents contact them regarding their thoughts on this issue; and further instructed staff to place this item on the next work session agenda for discussion.

b. **Opt-Out Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings** – City Administrator Radermacher and City Attorney Wetzel reviewed proposed Ordinance No. 89, Sixth Series, regarding opting-out of the recently passed legislation allowing Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings within the City. This item is on the regular agenda for consideration.

c. **Other**

1. Public Works Director Kimman reviewed that there is a public informational meeting scheduled for Thursday, August 4, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers with the Planning Commission to gain input from residents on the proposed updates to the City's Comprehensive Plan.
