

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ JUNE 5, 2017

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hanfler on June 5, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Councilmembers Lundberg, Liljegren, Hanson, Knafla, Council President Hanfler, and Mayor Zylka were present. Councilmembers Hircock and Gosiak were absent. It was determined there was a quorum.

2. **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Motion was made by Councilmember Hanson, seconded by Councilmember Lundberg to approve the agenda of the special City Council meeting of June 5, 2017, as presented. Ayes: Lundberg, Zylka, Hanfler, Liljegren, Hanson, and Knafla. Nays: none. Motion carried.

3. **NEW BUSINESS**

a. **Application for Show License, Garden Bros. Circus, Inc., Exchange Arena** – City Administrator Radermacher and City Attorney Wetzel reviewed a request from Kristina Salgado, Sarasota, Florida, representing Garden Bros. Circus, to allow a circus with animal at the Exchange Arena, 309 Southeast Eleventh Street, on Monday, June 5, 2017, beginning at 3:30 p.m. Devin and Sarah Chandler, Ringmaster and road management representing Garden Bros. Circus, reviewed their request. Motion was made by Councilmember Hanson, seconded by Councilmember Liljegren to approve the request of Garden Bros. Circus, Sarasota, FL, to allow a circus at the Little Falls Exchange Arena, 309 Southeast Eleventh Street, contingent upon the appropriate paperwork, background investigation, insurance and fees being provided, and approval is granted by the Fire and Police Chiefs. Following discussions, Councilmember Hanson rescinded his motion. Motion was then made by Mayor Zylka, seconded by Councilmember Liljegren to approve the Show Permit requested by Garden Bros. Circus without any animals at the Exchange Arena, 309 Southeast Eleventh Street, on June 5, 2017, contingent upon the appropriate paperwork, background investigation, insurance and fees being provided, and approval is granted by the Fire and Police Chiefs; and further required all animals be housed outside of the City limits. On a roll call vote; Ayes: Lundberg, Zylka, Liljegren, Hanson, and Knafla. Nays: Hanfler. Motion carried.
