

SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ SEPTEMBER 18, 2017

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hanfler on September 18, 2017, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.
