

SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ APRIL 20, 2020

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hircock on Monday, April 20, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom video conference under Minnesota Statute 13D.021, due to the Covid-19 health pandemic.
