

CANVASS OF MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS ~ NOVEMBER 5, 2020, AND NOVEMBER 12, 2020

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting of the City Council of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hircock on Thursday, November 3, 2020, at 12:00 p.m. via Zoom video conference under Minnesota Statute 13D.021, due to the COVID-19 health pandemic, to canvass the municipal elections of November 3, 2020. On a roll call Councilmembers Lundberg, Storlie, Hanson, Council President Hircock, and Mayor Zylka were present. Councilmembers Knafla, Liljegren, and Gosiak were absent. It was determined there was a quorum.

2. **CANVASS OF ELECTIONS**

Due to the health pandemic and the temporary changes granted by the State legislature, absentee ballots will be accepting, if postmarked on or before November 3, 2020, for seven days following the General Election, therefore the City Council recessed at 12:01 p.m. to November 12, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. On a roll call vote; Ayes: Lundberg, Zylka, Hircock, Storlie and Hanson. Nays: none. Motion carried.

3. **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting of the City Council of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hircock on Thursday, November 12, 2020, at 5:01 p.m. via Zoom video conference under Minnesota Statute 13D.021, due to the COVID-19 health pandemic, to canvass the municipal elections of November 3, 2020. On a roll call Councilmembers Knafla, Liljegren, Storlie, Hanson, Gosiak, Council President Hircock, and Mayor Zylka were present. Councilmember Lundberg was absent. It was determined there was a quorum.

2. **CANVASS OF ELECTIONS, CONTINUED**

The City Council reviewed the results of the November 3, 2020, municipal elections to fill the expiring terms of Councilmembers in First, Second, and Thirds Wards. Motion was made by Mayor Zylka, seconded by Councilmember Hanson to accept the Summary Statement of Voters of the Regular Municipal Election held on November 3, 2020, as submitted by the election judges; and further moved that if the City receives no challenges for a recount within seven days, to declare and certify the following winners: First Ward Councilmember Raquel Lundberg; Second Ward Councilmember Gerald Knafla; and Third Ward Councilmember Frank Gosiak. On a roll call vote; Ayes: Knafla, Liljegren, Zylka, Hircock, Storlie, Hanson, and Gosiak. Nays: none. Motion carried.

4. **ADJOURNMENT**

Council President Hircock recessed the meeting at 5:03 p.m.
