

SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ NOVEMBER 16, 2020

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hircock on Monday, November 16, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom video conference under Minnesota Statutes 13D.021, due to the COVID-19 health pandemic. d. **Correspondence from Mayor of Le Bourget, France** – Mayor Zylka reviewed a letter received from the newly elected Mayor Jean-Baptiste Borsali, le Bourget, France, wanting to continue our relationships as Sister Cities once the health crisis is over. No action taken.

It was the consensus of the City Council to add this item to the regular agenda.
