

**SPECIAL WORK SESSION CITY COUNCIL MEETING ~ MARCH 1, 2021**

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

The special work session City Council meeting of the City of Little Falls was called to order by Council President Hircock on Monday, March 1, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom video conference under Minnesota Statute 13D.021, due to the COVID-19 health pandemic. a. **Snowplowing Policy Amendment Discussions** – Public Works Director/Engineer Kimman reviewed City Policy 52, Snowplowing. The policy now allows for the snow accumulations of four (4") before the snowplows are called in to plow the roadways; and staff is looking at moving it to snow accumulations of two (2") or more. The City Council will continue to discuss at future meetings. No action taken.

b. **Surface and/or Utility Improvements, Fourteenth Street Southeast** – Public Works Director/Engineer Kimman reviewed the possible surface and/or utility improvements to Fourteenth Street Southeast southerly of Fifth Avenue Southeast. This project would only need to be considered if the proposing housing project by CADG be through. This item is on the regular agenda for consideration.

c. **Strategic Planning, Set Date and Facilitator** – City Administrator Radermacher reviewed the dates for the strategic planning meeting of the City Council including weekdays vs. weekends, facilitators, etc. Discussion to continue at the March 15, 2021, meeting. No action taken.

d. **Request for Proposals, One and Two Family Residential Recycling** – City Administrator Radermacher reviewed a proposed request for proposals for the City's one and two family recycling program. The current contract ends December 31, 2021. This item is on the regular agenda for consideration.

None.


6. **CONSTITUENT MESSAGE(S)**
