b. **Raised Garden Beds** – Fellow Phoebe Ward, reviewed an initiative by Local Foods Local Places, for raised garden beds to be placed in Gamradt Park to provide fresh produce and be an educational tool on where produce comes from. This project is in conjunction with Little Falls Schools and is funded by Morrison County Public Health. No action taken.
