Changes within Polling Places

With the current health pandemic and our goal to protect voters and election judges, you will see the following changes in the polling places:

- Voters are required to wear face coverings, if medically able.
- Practice Social distancing of six feet or more, which will be marked on the floor.
- Election judges will sanitize the poll pads and voting booths frequently.
- Voters are encouraged to bring their own black ink pen.

As we continually strive to do, our Elections Judges will be making every effort for a smooth and timely voting experience. You may however, run into delays at peak voting time, [before work, lunch time and immediately after work]. You may want to vote during off peak time to avoid possible delays or wait times.

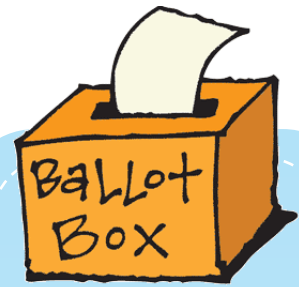
Primary Election Voting
