### REDISTRICTING ~ Where you vote may have changed:

As many of you know, the City of Little Falls redistricted the ward boundaries in March 2022 following the decennial Census as required by law. Redistricting is the process of redrawing the boundaries of election districts (wards) to ensure that the people of each district are equally represented. All three Ward boundaries within the City changed. (On the reverse of this newsletter you will find a map of the new boundaries.) All three polling places (where you vote), have stayed the same. Generally the Ward Boundaries are as follows:

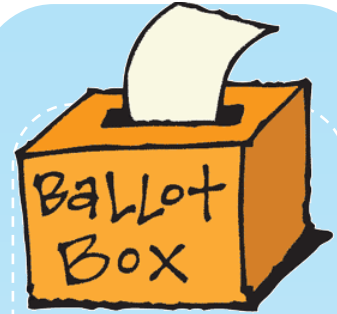
As they continually strive, your **Election Judges** will be making every effort for a smooth and timely voting experience. You may however, run into delays at peak voting time, [before work, lunch time and immediately after work]. You may want to vote during off peak time to avoid possible delays or wait times.

Please remember there is no campaigning allowed within the polling place or within 100 feet. This does include no displaying of campaign materials, literature, buttons, shirts, caps, etc. Please leave these items at home or in your vehicle before coming in to vote. (Minnesota Statute 204C.06)
