Effective immediately, March 26, 2020, all City Facilities, including City Hall and the Police Station will continued to be closed to the public. This order is in effect until further notice. Staff will have access to their facilities, those staff members so can work from home will be allowed to do so. Until further notice, all City Council and committee meetings will be held by telephone/other electronic means or postponed. We will continue to live streaming both the Work Session and Regular City Council meetings

Emergency personnel will be working, and you are encouraged to call those departments, if you have non-emergency concerns. If you have an emergency, please call dial 911. Prescription medication collection will be suspended until further notice.

The City will be waiving late fees on utility bills that are due April 5th. There are multiple payment options that allow you to pay without coming into City Hall. These include:

- Payment drop-boxes located:
 - City Hall parking lot – 100 7th Ave NE;
 - Morrison County Government Center – corner of First Street and Broadway Avenue East;
 - Coborn's Marketplace – 1101 2nd Ave NE; and
 - Casey's General Store – 500 West Broadway, on the westside.
- Payment by mail: City of Little Falls, P O Box 244, Little Falls, MN, 56345-0244.
