# What is new with Executive Order 20-56

---

Executive Order 20-48 will be rescinded after May 17<sup>th</sup>, but paragraphs 6 through 8 remain in place until June 1st.

- Paragraph 6 – Exemptions Critical Sectors
- Paragraph 7 – All exempt activity should follow safety guidelines
- Paragraph 8 – Non-Critical Exempt Business, Work from home must do so.

At-risk Persons are strongly urged to stay at home.

Activities outside of the home are allowed but limited.

- Outdoor Recreation Guidelines - <https://www.dnr.state.mn.us/covid-19.html>
- Gatherings – prohibited for 10 or more people, drive-in gatherings can be more than 10 people.
- Bars, restaurants, and other places of public accommodation closed until June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Non-critical Businesses – must establish and implement a COVID-19 preparedness plan (webinar information covers this).
- Customer Facing Business – requires workers and customers maintain physical distancing of 6 ft and store occupancy must not exceed 50 percent of the normal occupant capacity as determined by the fire marshal.

# What is continuing from 20-48

---

Paragraphs 6 through 8 remain in place until June 1st.

- Paragraph 6 – Exemptions Critical Sectors
- Paragraph 7 – All exempt activity should follow safety guidelines
- Paragraph 8 – Non-Critical Exempt Business, Work from home must do so.

Mask and face coverings are strongly encouraged.

Penalties for the violations of the order are still the same.
